Next the 2nd responsibility was assigned to the members of IGAC and requested them to submit on or before 04-03-2019 through our college email "ccermtm@igac-2019"





Feedback 2017-2019

The IQAC committee planned to collect feedback from the student teachers. The committee members assembled a questionnaire to assess the quality of our institution. Four areas are concentrated in the collection of feedback. They are Teaching-Learning Process in our Institution, Activities and Programmes in our College, Facilities provided by the Institution and the transfer of Motto, Vision, Mission and General Principles of our College.

The questionnaire was distributed to the student teachers and data were collected on 25-04-2019. Based on the data, the following statements are made.

The findings of *Teaching-Learning Process in our Institution* reveal that, about 63% of respondents are satisfied with the different statements and they have selected either 'agree' or 'strongly agree' for the statements. This concludes that, in our college, teacher educators are good in their duties.

The findings of *Activities and Programmes in our College* reveal that, about 69.3% of respondents are satisfied with the different statements and they have selected either 'agree' or 'strongly agree' for the statements. This concludes that, in our college, the Activities and Programmes exist in a systematic way.

The findings of *Facilities Providing by Institution* reveal that, about 64.86% of respondents are satisfied with the different statements and they have selected either 'agree' or 'strongly agree' for the statements. This concludes that, Facilities providing by our institution are very useful for our student teachers.

The findings of *Motto, Vision, Mission and General Principles* reveal that, about 71.14% of respondents are satisfied with the different statements and they have selected either 'agree' or 'strongly agree' for the statements.
