LOCATION

The Christian College of Education is owned and administered by Church of South India, Kanyakumari Diocese, Pioneer in the field of Education. It is located at Marthandam in a serene campus just a few yards away from the Kanyakumari-Trivandrum National Highways.

A BRIEF HISTORY

The National Council For Teacher Education by their Notification FTN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/4140 approved the College to be owned and administered by the Diocese as Self-financed Institution. The preliminary arrangements were carried by the then Bishop Most Rev. Dr. G. Devakadasham, the then Office-Bearers of the Diocese, Dr. A.J.Bensam, Prof. D. Christian Babu, Adv. S. Sathiyadhas and Adv. Robert Bruce. The Most Rev. Dr. G. Devakadasham is the founder Chairman of the College. Dr. Johnson V. Joel Singh was appointed as the first Correspondent/Secretary of the College. Dr. N. Beulah Jayanthi was appointed as the first Principal of the college. And the College was affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. In the year 2008, the College was affiliated to the then established Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University under the Tamil Nadu Act 33 of 2008. The new College building was formally inaugurated by the then Bishop/Chairman on 25-02-2006.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

Our College has a well-furnished Library with a Digital Resource Centre. The library has a good collection of books. Apart from books it has back volumes of Periodicals, Thesis, and CDs in different subjects. It has a Book-Bank facility. A question Bank is functioning in this library. It has on-line retrieval facilities to help the student - teachers and Teacher Educators.

Working Hours : The library is open on all working days from 9am to 5pm.

Membership : The library has an institutional membership of all the staff and students-teachers of this college. Apart from the institutional members, non - institutional users i.e Teacher Educators, School Teachers, Research Scholars, and Students-Teachers from neighbouring educational institutions and our Alumni also utilise the library for reference.

Library Collection : The library has a good collection of various resources like Books, Journals, Back Volumes of Periodicals, Thesis, CDs, News papers and Magazines. The library has a good collection of reference books such as Encyclopaedia, Dictionary, etc., The University question papers are collected and kept in the question bank for the benefit of the student-teachers.

Periodicals : The library subscribes various Journals, magazines and New papers to enhance the knowledge of the students-teachers in the competitive world.

Book Bank : The library has a book bank. The students-teachers can use this facility at free of cost.

Digital Resource Centre : In this ultra modern digital era, we can get digital information easily with the help of internet. Digital Resource Centre helps to access electronic resources like e-books, e-journals etc., Student-Teachers can access during college hours.

LIBRARY RULES

- ❖ Every Student-Teacher of this college is eligible for getting membership of the library.
- ❖ Members can borrow two books Login to the library is based on your Barcode in ID card.
- ❖ The books borrowed should be returned within 14 days, If not, an overdue charge of Rs. 1/- per volume per day will be levied.
- ❖ Members should bring their ID cards while visiting the library.
- ❖ Books are to be handled very carefully. If any book is damaged or lost while in possession, it has to be replaced with a new one .
- ❖ Borrowers are strictly forbidden to make markings or writings in the books.
- ❖ Borrowers must satisfy themselves with the physical condition of the books at the time of borrowing. They shall be held responsible for any damage or mutilation, detected at the time of return.
- ❖ Borrower is fully responsible for the book issued upon them.

- ❖ Members should make a written report to the librarian immediately on loss of the College ID.
- ❖ Perfect discipline and silence should be observed in and around the library.
- ❖ Umbrellas, bags, books, files etc., should be kept at the property shelf.
- ❖ Users are permitted to carry only loose sheet of paper and pen.
- ❖ Reference books, dictionaries, manuals, maps, periodicals, journals etc. are issued to the students for reference inside the library only.
- ❖ Users must return the books to the library when called by the librarian.

DIGITAL RESOURCE CENTRE

1. Users should get permission from the Librarian to use the Digital Resource Centre.
2. Student-Teachers should possess their college ID card, whenever they want to enter Digital Resource Centre.

3. Student-Teachers should bring their requests for utilizing the e-facility duly recommended by the concerned teachers. Such requests are not necessary during prescribed library hours.
4. Enter the login & logout time, and other particulars in the maintenance record provided in the section.
5. One user per system is allowed to work to avoid over crowd.
6. The peripherals should be handled with care. All storage devices should be scanned against virus before being used in the system.
7. Do not browse / visit websites other than Educational/ Scientific / Research / Government.
8. Do not alter the settings of the monitor / systems.
9. Do not chat and e-mail in the Digital Resource Centre.
10. The system should be properly shut down after use.
